

## How do online courses work?

- After registering for a course, you will receive a password to access the course site via the internet where you will work through the course lessons with other students.
- You will work on the course at a designated time each day at your school, but you will also have access to the course from home in the evenings and on weekends.
- Your assignments will include readings, writing reports, formulating reactions, and participating in online discussions with fellow students.
- Your course instructor will be available for additional help if needed.

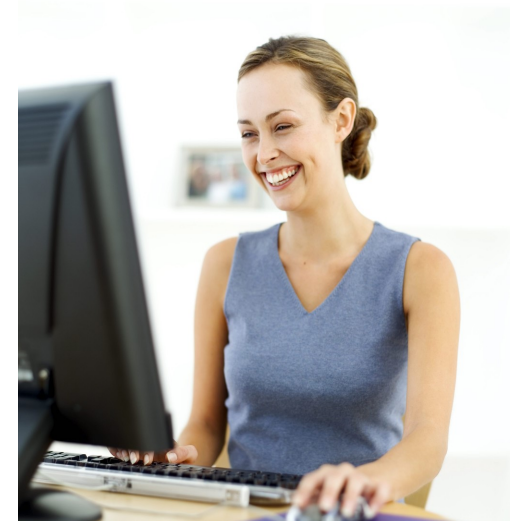
